MCDEVCO continues to support Marathon County with resources such as municipality connection, entrepreneurial development and *GAP* financing to enhance the landscape of new and expanding businesses. Here is what MCDEVCO has been up to as it relates to each of these objectives since 2022 kicked off!

On behalf of MCDEVCO, thank you for your continued support and partnership in our organization. Whether you contribute your time, funds or support by reading this newsletter...we thank YOU!

As 2022 comes to a close, we reflect on a year of progress and results and look forward to a year of growth achievements.

At MCDEVCO, we are proud of the following milestones for the year and confidently look ahead to a bright 2023 with your support and partnership!

- Occupancy at the Entrepreneurial & Education Center (EEC): MCDEVCO assumed the management of the EEC in January 2021. To date, MCDEVCO is happy to report an increase of 23% in occupancy, with 84% of the EEC occupied.
- **GAP Financing:** MCDEVCO has successfully disbursed over \$300,000.00 in *GAP* financing funds to local business start-ups and expansions. We are only getting started!
- Entrepreneurial Education: In 2022, MCDEVCO hosted six workshops for Marathon County Entrepreneurs, and is in the final stages of its cornerstone program: *GEARS* Certificate of Entrepreneurial Excellence. This 16-week course provides the fundamentals involved in starting a business. MCDEVCO's business launch rate post course graduation is 30%. This is up 20% from years past.
